Supporting Your Community Just Got Easier!

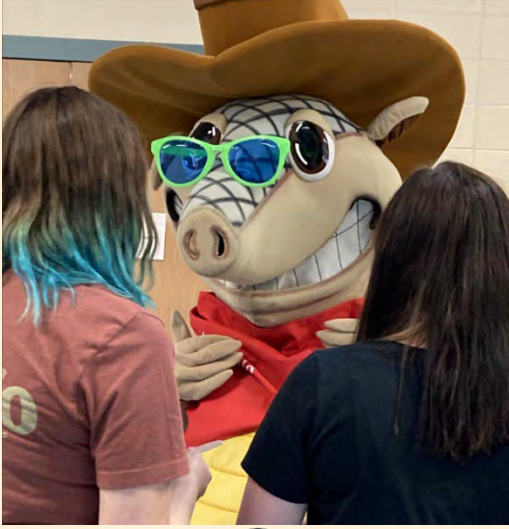

Eventually removed from her home, she came to us thinking about how she could create a better future for her baby. We suggested a diploma as a good first step. THREE WEEKS after making this decision, she was awarded her GED! Proud of her accomplishment and shown how she could go even further through college classes or technical training, her plan upon reunification and the birth of her baby is to continue on this path.
