## MotoHunt Details

### REGISTRATION

1. Registration and prizes are per bike. If you wish to ride with another, you can (although only 1 person can be in all the hunt photos). Register online at <https://NewFoundationsChildren.com/motohuntreg> or from the QR code to the right.
2. Payment can be by credit/debit card or bank account through the online form. If you prefer not to register online, you may register in person at 2300 Standridge Road, Anderson, M-F 9am to 5pm.



### GENERAL RULES

1. Please ride legally: hold a valid Class M driver's license; have your bike currently registered; make sure the bike and the rider are insured; PLEASE wear a helmet; Operate your bike safely and within the speed limit.
2. Riders are expected to act in a sportsman-like fashion at all times.
3. PLEASE DON'T CHEAT.
4. Please render aid to fellow participants or the public under emergency or life-threatening conditions.

### HOW IT WORKS

1. Be registered before 5pm on Friday, September 22, 2023.
2. On Friday the 22nd after 6pm, you will be emailed the Hunt List and your participant number. The list will include objects, landscapes, businesses, and signs that are assigned points depending on how hard or easy they are to find or reach. For those items on the list marked with an asterisk (\*), you will double your points if you include an additional photo of a receipt from that place with legible date, time, and business name. You DO NOT have to find or photograph all the items or do them in any order. If you like, you can map out a route that evening but no "hunting" is to be done before Saturday.
3. PRINT both the Hunt List and your participant number to carry with you.
4. You can start your hunt at 8am Saturday. Time is up Sunday at 5pm. How you use those hours is up to you – ride one day, both days, ride evenings only or just mornings.
5. To earn points, you must take a picture of yourself with your helmet/bike plus your participant number with, in front of, or holding the item. The person in the photos must be the same person in all your photos. For double point receipts, include your participant number in the photo or write it on the receipt.
6. Once you have taken the photo, hashtag it with **#motohunt**, and upload to your Instagram or Facebook account. If you like, you can save all your photos and upload them at one time. Just make sure they are all uploaded by 5pm on Sunday, the 24th.
7. Sunday evening, we will tally the points for each bike and determine 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. These will be announced on the @NewFoundationsChildren Facebook and Instagram pages Tuesday! In the case of a tie, we will select the hunter who registered for the event first.
